Available speaking opportunities:

A. Opening / Closing Keynote (30 minutes each)

Extension of the core railway vehicle conference topic: added perspectives, related issues, insights from other industries.

Opening Keynote: Interiors & public transport in transition

Which trends are currently shaping public transport? How do manufacturers, suppliers and designers respond to changing lifestyles, workplaces and mobility patterns?

Which possibilities, opportunities and challenges is the industry facing?

Closing Keynote: Visions for an intelligent & sustainable future mobility

What future issues and trends will influence public transport?

How will we travel in the future? How will interiors change?

B. Partner Sessions (20 min. each)

How can new solutions and technologies improve the railway travel experience? How can cross-industry and multi-disciplinary development processes succeed?

Speakers from businesses, research institutions and design consultancies present a joint project and their respective perspectives on the cooperation and development process. The focus will be on questions such as: "WHY?" (what were the project goal and scope? how were they determined? which user wishes were addressed?); "HOW?" (how was the project implemented? How was the user perspective included? which learnings emerged from the cooperation?); "WHAT?" (what were the results of the cooperation?). Sessions will be followed by moderated Q&A sessions with the audience.

Partner Session 2: Project in the cockpit

Possible topics (examples):

- Passenger area (well-being, travel experience)
- Cockpit (user experience, security, networking)
- Smart Train (networked services for operators, personnel and passengers)
- Train team and personnel (services, improvement of the working environment)
